A Dutch decorated Leeds creamware plate Onse Live Vrouw Tot Kevelaar (Our Lady to Kevelaar), circa 1780, colourfully painted with the Virgin Mary and Christ within a floral border, diameter 24.5cm, together with a Delft plate painted in blue with a chinoiserie garden, diameter 20cm, and a Worcester blue painted K'ang Hsi Lotus pattern dish, diameter 19.3cm (faults and repairs).

Condition Report

Kevelaar plate - an approximate one quarter section of the rim has been broken off between 9 and 12 o'clock in one large section and two smaller focused around the 12 o'clock point. This has been visibly (museum style) restored. There is a similar restored haircrack to the rim at 4 o'clock, and an unrestored haircrack to the broken section at 10 o'clock. The lilac enamel in particular has flaked and been re-touched in a number of areas - these areas are then flaking again. The other enamels have some minimal flaking.

Delft plate - typical overall fritted chipping to the rim circumference.

Worcester plate - badly cracked.
