A set of four Doulton Lambeth stoneware spirit flasks, each with diamond registration lozenge to base date coded for 1880, of shouldered square shape with incised arched vertical line decoration beneath stylized foliate detail, the handles marked 'SW' (Scotch Whisky), 'G' (Gin), 'IW' (Irish Whisky), and 'B' (Brandy), each fitted with a gilt metal mounted cork stopper, impressed and incised marks to bases, height 22.5cm.

Estimate: £300 - £400

Condition Report

Overall each bottle is in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The Brandy bottle has a blemish to one of the fan-shaped leaves on the shoulders next to the handle - I would suggest this is a manufacturing flaw as it would be a strange and awkward place to chip without also sustaining damage to the handle.
