LOT 1840

A craquelure ice glass comport with entwined gilt detailed red snake decoration to the stem, Bohemian or French, circa 1850, diameter of top 23cm, a similar centrepiece with entwined green snake fitted with a matched trumpet with entwined red snake, overall height 39.5cm, a matching goblet with entwined red snake, a pair of frosted glass goblets with entwined blue snakes, height 25.5cm, and a mixed group of other craquelure ice glass, including six assorted jugs, other trumpet centrepiece fittings and two comports (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Pair goblets with blue snakes - both snakes are missing pretty much all of their decoration.

Goblet with red snake - missing end of snake's tail.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

There is some typical wear to the gilding commensurate with age and handling, and some minuscule and inconsequential nicks to some of the cut rims.
