A mixed group of mostly English and some Continental porcelain, mainly 20th century, including a Royal Crown Derby Royal Antoinette pattern plate, diameter 26.5cm, a Copeland Spode floral and gilt decorated plate with salmon pink rim, diameter 21cm, a Spode Stafford Flowers plate, diameter 23.8cm, a Sèvres style floral painted pink ground plate, a Samson Swan Service style plate, diameter 20.8cm, a Mintons teacup and saucer painted with blue forget-me-nots and two pieces of Royal Crown Derby Derby Posies, comprising a jug and trinket dish.

Condition Report

Swan service style plate - gilt painted over narrow chip approx 1.5cm long to upper rim edge at 1 o'clock and smaller nick to very rim edge at 8 o'clock.

Magenta rimmed plate - cracked and stained.

Spode Trapnell Sprays plate - knife cuts.

Mintons forget-me-not cup and saucer - cup is crazed with tiny vertical haircrack by handle, saucer is cracked.

Spode blue printed can and saucer - saucer crazed, gilding worn.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
