A mixed group of English and Continental porcelain, 19th and 20th century, including three Capodimonte Swan Service style plates, diameter 23.5cm, a pair of Chelsea Derby style putti holding baskets of flowers, height 12.5cm, a green ground Worcester style part dessert service decorated with panels of exotic birds, butterflies and flowers, a Coalport type teapot and cover decorated with birds, insects and flowering branches, a Royal Crown Derby miniature teapot and cover and two Crown Staffordshire miniatures (minor faults).

Condition Report

3 Swan Service style plates - one has a tiny nick to the upper rim edge at 10 o'clock, each has minor wear to the cavetto.

Pair putti - some tiny very minor chips to bocage.

Dessert service - bowl has minuscule nick to outer edge of rim, bowl and square dish display some light wear, minuscule nick to underside edge of one plate and some wear to the cavetto of each plate, otherwise ok.

Coalport type teapot - crack to upper handle terminal and around spout where joins body, tiny nicks to end of spout.

Apricot ground teapot and cover - crazed, light wear, two cracks to cover.

Small mirror - chipping and glued repair to pink ribbon, mirror glass a replacement, small chips/losses to relief flowers and foliage.

Miniature Royal Crown Derby teapot - chip to tip of spout.

Remaining items in lot in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
