### LOT 1438

A pair of Hadley's Worcester vases, circa 1900, painted with cornflowers and buttercups within enameled scroll moulded framing, flanked by shot enamelled goats head handles, the blue glazed waisted stems on brown glazed square bases with hoof feet, green printed and red painted factory marks to bases, heights 18.5cm and 19cm (faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

First vase - a couple of teeny tiny nicks to the hoof feet which are very inconsequential and only noticeable on VERY close inspection.

Second vase - the square foot and blue glazed stem are badly cracked. The body is crazed. One of the goat head handles is missing part of its ear and has a haircrack across its nose.
