Male - small chip to outer left side edge of base, 2 absolutely tiny nicks to hem of pink frock coat, missing end of one of the spare spigot's held aloft in left hand. Otherwise in good condition with no restoration. Female - 3 small chips to front outer edge of base and one tiny nick to side edge of base, tiny nick to front of hat brim and some losses to the lacy ends of her dress which are very inconsequential. Otherwise in good condition overall with no restoration.
