A pair of French bisque porcelain figures, late 19th century, modelled as a gallant sending a love letter attached to a dove, his female companion receiving the letter, both standing on oval bases with red beaded and turquoise banded detail, indistinct incised marks to bases, height 36cm.

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

Female - area of restoration to front left edge of blue trimmed section of dress, left index finger restored. Small flat chip to left side edge of base, very inconspicuous, and an even smaller nick to the other side of the base.

Male - top section of letter held in right hand restored, minor nicks to frilled edges of cravat, tiny spot of restoration (hardly noticeable) to left base corner of pink frock coat.

These issues are very minor. Overall in good order.
