An early George V silver capstan inkwell of slightly tapered cylindrical form, the hinged lid framed by five quill holes within a raised rim, on a wide circular base, Chester 1911 by George Nathan & Ridley Hayes, weight 306.3g, diameter 15cm, and a silver rectangular cigarette box, Birmingham 1935 by Walker & Hall, length 17.8cm.

## Condition Report

316. Inkwell - in generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge lid is in good order. Minor chips to glass liner. Base slightly misshapen but sits flat. Slightly misshapen but sits flat. Slight rubbing to hallmarks but still readable. No inscriptions or erasures.

Cigarette box - engraved monogram to top. Numerous nicks and small dents to lid and sides, particularly to corners. Typical surface scratches and wear. Hinge is good and lid closes tightly. Slightly rubbed hallmarks.
