A Moser amber tinted crackle glass vase, 1900-25, of flattened bulbous shape beneath an extended neck, enamelled with fish amidst aquatic weed, unmarked, height 19cm, (crack to neck) together with a similar smaller example, enamelled with a fish and aquatic weed, height 6cm, an example decorated with just aquatic weed, height 13.5cm, and a similar vase decorated in relief with fish (neck reduced). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Flattened bulbous shaped largest vase - 2.5cm long crack to neck, not immediately apparent due to the nature of the crackled body, otherwise ok.

Vase with relief fish - neck reduced, the remaining rim is uneven with some chipping to it.

Other two items in the lot are both in good condition with no damage or repairs.
