A Royal Worcester Prismatic Enamels decorated tall oil lamp base, dated 1895, the bulbous top painted with flowers between moulded borders and with four high relief mask terminals, raised on an extended fluted column stem painted with flowers above an elaborately moulded square base with gilt enriched pale turquoise and pink enamelled detail, puce printed marks to base with model No. 1789, height 59.5cm.

Condition Report

Broken in two and re-stuck between the base of the column stem and the top of the foot. There are some small losses along the break line and some associated small losses and chips to the detail of the foot which are only noticeable on closer inspection.
