### Condition Report

302. Tiffany spoon - good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Engraved monogram to back of handle. Typical light surface scratches and wear, but decoration still crisp. Slightly rubbed marks to back, we would suggest the spoon is somewhere early to mid 20th century.

Shell spoon - good condition, no significant damage or repairs, only typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks.
