### Condition Report

2156. Overall appearance and generally comes across quite well, but typically there is some old woodworm around the lower sections of the legs and some overall scuffs, marks and a few cracks to the timber. All four legs have been re-spliced with later tips and there is a crack to the top of one leg. Other scattered woodworm around legs and stretchers and a crack to the joint of one stretcher end. Later hardboard bases added to the drawers. All fairly typical for a provincial softwood table of this type.
