### Condition Report

340. The pot is in generally good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear, few tiny nicks/minor dents to body. No erasures. Hinge is good and closes flush. The foot sits nice and flat. Good clear hallmarks and part marks to lid.
