A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose turquoise ground porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, each applied with gilt Buddhistic lion handles and chilong to shoulders, the tapering body and flared neck painted with dragons amidst peonies, unmarked, height 25.7cm.

Condition Report

1089. Both vases are in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. No cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light surface wear to gilt and enamels. Decoration is good and vibrant. Some areas of enamel loss to turquoise ground and blue flowers in particular.
