A late Victorian Wedgwood majolica pottery water jug, inscribed with motto bands within turquoise cabochon borders, maker's stamp and registration lozenge to underside, height 19.5cm, together with a matching tappit lid jug (cracked).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Jug - overall fine crazing to the glaze, there is a minor vertical haircrack to the side edge of the spout which is approx 2.5cm long, and the pointed tip of the spout has lost its glaze. There is a glued chip to the outer edge of the footrim approx 2cm long by 0.5cm deep.

Tappit lid jug - very badly cracked and rivet repaired.
