A pair of Bohemian amber flashed and engraved glass vases, first half 20th century, of low bellied faceted shape engraved with a chequerboard pattern of fruiting vine, height 11cm, a Bohemian ruby flashed spa beaker, 19th century, engraved with The Three Norns, height 11.8cm, and a small group of similar flashed mostly European glass, including a green flashed and cut decanter and stopper, an amethyst engraved and cut dome shaped shade, height 18cm, a white and gilt decorated decanter bottle and four assorted glasses (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Spa beaker - some insignificant nicks/bruising to faceted detail around top of foot.

Opaque white horizontally banded decanter/carafe has no stopper, significant gilding loss and small manufacturing blemish to one of the horizontal bands.

Opaque white decanter bottle has no stopper and wear to the gilding.

Green cabochon decanter has no stopper.

Green flashed decanter has minor chipping to the base end of the stopper.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.
