"A large mixed group of mostly Stourbridge air trap satin glassware, late 19th century, including vases, jugs and posy holders, predominantly with a quilted diamond design but also chevrons, trails and spots, in blue, pink, yellow, cranberry and caramel colours, three stands marked 'PATENT' to the base (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass."

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Caramel coloured vase with rigaree collar has minuscule nick to rim.

Brown striped small posy has crack to rim.

Pale blue chevron vase with frill rim has minor bruise to side.

Peach coloured single handled jug with chipping to 'pulled' detail of handle terminal.

Cranberry vase with wave detail and frilled rim has bruise to side.

Pale blue two-handled vase has chipping to handle terminals.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition with no repairs or significant damage.
